We focus on ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) test preparation, leadership, physical fitness development, military career exploration, and basic military subjects. As a supplemental opportunity, Sierra High School also offers the after-school Military Explorers Program for all District students. Students are exposed to hundreds of careers and technical training offered to them to serve our nation. Students will leave the program with many opportunities and hands-on classroom experiences, working with teachers and students at all grade levels. Students will receive training in:

- Reading, mathematics, and vocabulary support
- Career exploration
- Military recruiter conferences
