- 1. Login to **Aeries**.
- 2. From the **Navigation** Tree, click on the **Reports** icon.
- 3. Type **promotion** in the **Filter Reports...** field.
- 4. Click on **SB_No Promotion With Consideration** link.
 - You may be asked to login to the Report Server.
 - Use **sbc-district\firstnamelastname** and your District password.
- 5. Select the **School Year**.
- View Report 6. Click on the **View Report** button in the upper right corner.
- 7. Click on the floppy disk icon and select **WORD**.



- 8. If prompted to **Save**, select the desired location and then open the file.
- 9. Fill in the following:
 - **Status**, X the box for **Retained** or **Promotion with Consideration**.
 - **Reason**, X the box of the appropriate letter using the Reason codes listed on the form.
 - Consideration, X the box of the appropriate letter using the Consideration codes listed on the form.
- 10. When you have completed the form, save it and email it to the person designated by your principal to input the information into Aeries.
