

LOGGING IN TO YOUR COMPUTER VIA WINDOWS HELLO


Windows Hello is a more personal, more secure way to get instant access to your Windows 10 or 11 devices using a PIN, facial recognition, or fingerprint. You'll need to set up a PIN as part of setting up fingerprint or facial recognition sign-in, but you can also sign in with just your PIN. These options help make it easier and safer to sign into your PC because your PIN is only associated with one device and it's backed up for recovery with your Microsoft account.

At your Windows login window, enter your District credentials.

Example: firstnamelastname
Your District password




Depending on your computer's hardware (if you have a camera or a fingerprint reader), you can register facial recognition or fingerprint credentials. Facial and fingerprint are optional and can be skipped. Either way you will still need to create a 6-digit PIN.



The Windows Hello feature will appear.

Click on OK.



The Approve sign in required window will appear on your computer.

Approve the sign in request with your phone.



Enter a 6-digit PIN, confirm the PIN and click OK.



Click on OK.
